

Come Follow Me - Old Testament  
Week 22 : May 23 - May 29 ~ Joshua 1-8; 23-24

\*\*\* In preparation for this week's CFM you may want to read and highlight parts you would like to cover throughout the week in the section Thoughts to Keep in Mind: The Historical Books in the Old Testament found just prior to this week's outline

Monday - Read the introduction for this week's CFM. Introduce word of the week and discuss.

FHE - How do you think Joshua felt replacing Moses? Read Joshua 1:9. How can this scripture help you when you feel inadequate? Work on memorization of this scripture. Ideas: a puzzle that you slowly take pieces away, put it to a song, break it up on index cards and slowly take away parts/phrases, etc.

Tuesday - Read the section "Both faith and works are necessary for salvation" in the CFM manual. Read "Joshua and the Spies" on pg 128 of The Beginner's Bible

Wednesday - Watch "Joshua the Prophet" found in Old Testament Stories on the Gospel Library app or in the CFM manual for primary: younger children. Watch "Rahab and the Spies" found in the Old Testament stories or the CFM manual for primary: for older children.

Thursday - Read and discuss the section "I can experience God's 'wonders' if I have faith in Jesus Christ" in the CFM manual

Friday - Read The Battle of Jericho on p132 in The Beginner's Bible (covers Joshua 6) and read and discuss "Obedience brings God's power into my life" in the CFM manual

Sunday - Read and discuss the section "Cleave unto the Lord your God" in the CFM manual. Journal any thoughts or impressions you receive. Review the word of the week and discuss lessons from church that day.
