

Come Follow Me - Old Testament

Week 33 : Aug 8 - Aug 14 ~ Psalms 1-2; 8; 19-33; 40; 46

Monday - Read the introduction for this week's CFM. Introduce word of the week and discuss.

FHE - Read and discuss the section in the CFM manual titled, The Psalms teach us to trust in the Lord

Tuesday - Read "The Lord is My Shepherd" on pg 190 in The Beginner's Bible (covers Psalm 23) and listen to the hymn The Lord is My Shepherd and discuss.

Wednesday - Read and discuss the section, "The earth is full of the goodness of the Lord" in the CFM manual

Thursday - Read and discuss the section in the CFM manual title, The word of the Lord is powerful, "rejoicing the heart". When discussing 19:7-11 point out what is gained by listening to the word of the Lord and when discussing section 29 point out that the voice of the Lord is not always LOUDER than those locations and situations but STRONGER. The spirit can bear witness to and touch your heart above the noise of the water and the fire, etc. The noise of the world can be quieted and peace can be stronger than all of the noise as we listen to the Lord.

Friday - Read and discuss Psalm 33. Notice how many times "all" is used in this psalm. What do we learn about the Lord from the repeated use of this word, especially in verses 13-15?

Sunday - Read Psalm 46:10 and discuss. How does knowing that all will eventually recognize/acknowledge and exalt Jesus Christ give us peace in our decision to follow Him? Review the word of the week and discuss what you learned in classes today at church.
