

Come Follow Me - Old Testament

Week 36 : Aug 29 - Sept 4 ~ Prov 1-4; 15-16; 22; 31; Ecc 1-3; 11-12

Monday - Read the introduction for this week's CFM. Introduce word of the week and discuss.

FHE - How do our words affect those around us and therefore the spirit in our home? Take a small square of parchment paper or foil and put a dab of toothpaste on it. This represents saying something mean. Put some more toothpaste on and it represents saying something hurtful. More, it represent lying. Now put the toothpaste back into the tube. You cannot! Even if you wipe the foil clean, you may have repented and have been forgiven, but the person you said those things to (represented by the foil) is still affected. That foil will still smell like mint, there still may be some smears of toothpaste remaining. Read Proverbs 15;1-2, 18; 16:24, 32. Discuss Song: Kindness Begins with Me.

Tuesday - Read Proverbs 1:7; 2:5; 16:6; Ecclesiastes 12:13 but replace the word fear with words like reverence, love or obedience. How does this affect the way we think about these verses? How do we show that we fear the Lord?

Wednesday - Hand a child a broom and tell them the broom represents "their own understanding". Tell another child to lean against a table, dresser, cabinet or other sturdy item and tell them it represents trusting in the Lord. Tell both children to balance on one foot during the duration of CFM today. Read Proverbs 3:5-7 and discuss tying in the visual given at the beginning.

Thursday - Read and discuss "Incline thine ear unto wisdom" in CFM manual

Friday - Read "A woman that feareth the Lord, she shall be praised" in CFM manual

Sunday - Review the word of the week and discuss what you learned in classes today at church.
