

Come Follow Me - Old Testament

Week 49: Nov 28 - Dec 4 ~ Nahum; Habakkuk; Zephaniah

Monday - Read the introduction for this week's CFM. Introduce word of the week and discuss.

FHE - As we read the following verses in Nahum lets write down attributes of Jesus Christ and what we can do to benefit from them. Read verses 3-5 (slow to anger, powerful, cleanses); vs 7 (stronghold; we must have faith in Him); verses 13-15 (merciful; we must follow Him and put no other god/image before Him and keep the commandments/be obedient. Song: Seek the Lord Early

Tuesday - Habakkuk questions the Lord about why He seems to be just standing by and watching as the wicked overtake the righteous. Read Habakkuk 2:1-4 and discuss what we learn about waiting on the Lord's time. Are we every being left to just be overtaken by the wicked? Read Habakkuk 3:17-19 and discuss how his attitude has changed when he trusts in the Lord and His timing

Wednesday - Listen to the talk "Waiting upon the Lord: Thy Will Be Done" by Robert D. Hales. (Link can be found on the Gospel Library app in this weeks CFM at the bottom of the section "Habakkuk: I can trust the Lord's will and His timing")

Thursday - As we read Zephaniah 2:1-3; 3:12-13, 18-19 lets list the characteristics of the people God will preserve

Friday - Read Zephaniah 3:14-20. What blessings are we promised if we follow Him? Why is it important for us to know this?

Sunday - We discussed throughout the week the importance of seeking the Lord and the blessings that come as we do so. What are some ways we can seek the Lord? Discuss what we learned at church and review the word of the week.
