

Come Follow Me - New Testament
Week 16: April 17-23 ~ Matthew 18; Luke 10

Monday - Read the introduction for this week's CFM.

FHE - Read Matthew 18:1-15. Why would Jesus want us to become like a little child? What attributes do children have that we can develop to become more Christlike? Refer to Mosiah 3:19 for ideas. Read Matthew 18:15. How can we apply the counsel given in that verse to our family interactions? How could doing this bless our family? Listen to this mashup of [Jesus Loves the Little Children of the World/He's Got the Whole World in His Hands](#) by Caleb and Kelsey and discuss. Watch [Always Remember](#) by Angie Killian and discuss. Journal as prompted.

Tuesday - Do the section "I must forgive others if I am to receive forgiveness from the Lord" in the CFM manual.

Wednesday - Today we will discuss/review who the Seventy are and what their purpose is. Read Luke 10:1-20 followed by the paragraph "Who are the Seventy?" in the CFM manual.

Thursday - Read the first paragraph of the section "To obtain eternal life, I must love God and love my neighbor as myself". Read The Good Samaritan in The Beginner's Bible starting on p379. Read the 2nd paragraph of the previously mentioned section in the CFM manual. Watch [Parable of the Good Samaritan](#). Answer questions in the 3rd paragraph of the previously mentioned section. Watch [A Good Samaritan](#) and discuss how we can be a good Samaritan in our daily life.

Friday - Read Luke 10:38-42. Read the section "We choose "that good part" by making daily choices that lead to eternal life" in the CFM manual. Journal ways you can put the Lord first and what blessings will come to you as you do. Watch the following [music video](#) and discuss. Note: Sim Eu Te Seguirei is Portuguese for Lord, I Will Follow Thee.

Sunday - Discuss your thoughts on the bonus talk if you haven't already done so. Watch The Chosen.
