

Come Follow Me - New Testament  
Week 19: May 8-14 ~ Matthew 19-20; Mark 10; Luke 18

Monday - Read the introduction for this week's CFM.

FHE - Read Matthew 20: 25-28; Mark 10: 42-45. What is the meaning of the phrase "whosoever will be chief among you, let him be your servant"? How did Jesus Christ exemplify this principle? How can we follow His example in our family, our ward, [our friend group], and our neighborhood? (pulled from CFM manual Ideas for Family Scripture Study and Home Evening)

Tuesday - Read Matthew 19:16-22. This account may prompt you to ask, "What lack I yet?" (Matthew 19:20). How does the Lord help us make up for what we lack? Read Ether 12:27. What can we do to prepare ourselves to accept His correction and help as we seek to improve? (pulled from the section "If I ask the Lord, He will teach me what I need to do to inherit eternal life" in the CFM manual)

Wednesday - Have the kids race from one side of the yard to the other. Tell them there will be a prize for the winner. Once the race is done give each child the same prize starting with the person in last place and ending with the person who finished first. Read Matthew 20:1-16. What does this teach us about who receives the blessings of eternal life in Heavenly Father's plan? Listen to the talk "[The Laborers in the Vineyard](#)" by Elder Jeffrey R. Holland. What from this talk might help you see new ways to apply this parable? Journal any additional promptings the Spirit gives you.

Thursday - Do the section "I should trust God's mercy, not my own righteousness" in the CFM manual

Friday - Watch the video "[I Think When I read That Sweet Story](#)". What might it have been like to be among the children Jesus blessed? What might it mean to "receive the kingdom of God as a little child"?

Sunday - Watch The Chosen.
